

		Mobile Marathon FULL Marathon Relay Roster (5 participants) January 11, 2026

The Mobile Marathon relay division will compete Sunday, January 11, 2026. Each Full Marathon team will consist of five persons with four members running/walking 5 miles and the last member running/walking 6.2 miles. Team competition will be encouraged with awards in the following divisions: Open, Masters, Grand Masters, Senior Grand Masters, Organization, High school and Grade school. Each division will feature all male, all female and coed categories (Coed teams must have at least one male and one female participant.)

Team captains will receive packets with relay instruction sheets, wristband and 2 bib numbers for each team member. Each team member will wear one bib on their front and one on their back to allow for team /division identification throughout the marathon. Team members will be responsible for getting to the appropriate transition area (5, 10, 15, and 20 mile marks) and getting back to the finish line. Team members should check in with a relay marshal when they arrive in their transition area. Each team will be given a wristband that will be worn initially by the first leg runner. The wristband will be passed to the next participant at the appropriate relay station. All relay stations will be monitored by a course marshal to ensure the fair exchange of the wristband. If the team wristband is not worn by a runner, the team could be disqualified. If your team does not turn in a wristband at the finish, your team could be disqualified. **Only the last member from each team, wearing the bib with the CHIP, will cross the finish line for scoring purposes.** The person crossing the finish line will receive 5 finisher medallions.

Team entries will require a completed team roster, completed and signed individual race applications, and the team entry fee. Changes in team rosters may be made at Packet Pick-up on Saturday, January 11th, prior to obtaining the team race packets. Any new team member MUST provide a completed and signed individual application, otherwise, the team entry will NOT be changed.

Course support will be the same as for the marathon. The Marathon course will be a double-loop of the Half Marathon course. All participants receive a t-shirt and an invitation to the post-race meal.

Race-day team registration or team category changes will NOT be allowed.

Individual team members must also complete a Race Application form.

Complete the form and mark the Events "Marathon" and "FULL Relay".

- Individual team members' registration fee is covered under the Team registration fee.
- Individual team members who also wish to participate in either the Half Marathon or the Full Marathon will be required to register for those events separately. Each will receive an additional bib.

AWARDS: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for each division / category. Grade school will only be awarded 1st place.
